**A. Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by Jeff Creger at 02:06 P.M. It was determined that a quorum was present.

**B. Order of Business:**

1. **Approval of Consent Agenda:** Bob Amosson made a motion to approve the August 19, 2008 consent agenda, seconded by Karen Crimmings, motion carried.

**D. Revenue and Expenditures-Review**

1. **The Financial Report** was reviewed.

**E. Local Empowerment Board Programs**

1. **Preschool Scholarship Program:** We have received in the office as of 08/11/2008 53 applications or requests for applications. I have printed 250 preschool scholarship applications and distributed them to all preschools in the three counties, and some outside the county that have requested them. I have also handed posters out to preschool that wanted them to post. I met with Mason City Preschools on 08/04/2008 to discuss changes in the scholarship applications and to promote to the preschools the importance of getting the word to their families that these are available. As of 08/11/2008 we have 38 children approved for services. With a total of \$31,995 allocated to these scholarships. We have 11 pre-applications to be returned with the full applications. 1 family waiting on more information to verify if family qualifies. We have denied 3 families; 2 families were denied due to residence out of the three counties, and 1 denied for too high of income. Our budget for the 2008-2009 year is \$100,000, and have \$68,005 left to allocate to families.

2. **Outdoor Learning Environments:** This project is still in the process of being created and finalized. New estimated time of training to start will be in October and then another one before the first of the year. Original time line started in September, but had to be pushed back to give more time to create the curriculum of the training and get it approved so that it could be used towards providers credits.

3. **Awareness Campaign:** Cody met with the Mason City Preschools in early August. Plan to talk via phone in the other counties to find needs. Will create childcare and preschool committee to discuss Awareness Campaign.

4. **Preschool Survey:** Cody met with the Mason City Preschools in early August. Sent out survey copies to all preschools. Should have initial data for November meeting. This will be all registered 4 year old preschoolers in Mason City. Another survey will be completed in late May to cover any new preschoolers after the September 30<sup>th</sup> day. The hope is to get a true picture of preschool needs in Mason City.

**F. New Business:**

1. **08-09 Budget Update with New Programs & Final Financials:** Deb Quintus made a motion to approve the changes to the budget, seconded by Gary Van Hemert, motion carried.

2. **2007-2008 Annual Report (Review & Acceptance):** Bob Amosson made a motion to approve the 2007-2008 Annual Report as presented, seconded by Mary Ingham, motion carried.

3. **Contract for CCR&R QRS Specialist:** Karen Crimmings made a motion to approve the CCR&R QRS Support Specialist contract, seconded by Kristie Parks, motion carried.

- 4. State Board Meeting Update (September 11 &12):** Cody Williams reviewed the plans for the State Board meeting and the QRS recognition reception. Cody asked for ideas for the program on Thursday evening.
- 5. Report to the Board of Options for Funding Training Opportunities: Cody handed ideas for training for preschools and providers in the area.** Tabled until the next meeting due.
- 6. Appeal RFP-2 Learning Connections (Recommendations of the Executive Committee):** Karen Crimmings made a motion to accept the recommendations of the Executive Committee to deny the appeal by Learning Connections, seconded by Kristie Parks, motion carried. Abstained: Gary Van Hermert.
- 7. Plan for any additional non-allocated funds left: Annual Report Update:** Janet Gartin state TA presented concerns of the Learning Connections Program to the board.  
Linda Prestholt made a motion that the board recommend funding the Learning Connections program for \$133,522.03, If and only if, Learning Connections works with the State and Empowerment Board to make sure the application meets all the guidelines and criteria. Seconded by Susan Schillter. Motion carried. Gary Van Hermert abstained. Bob Amosson will chair this review committee.

**G. Public Input and Announcements:**

- Dwight Pierson commended the board for their hard work and vocalized his support for the Learning Connections program.

**H. Adjourn:** Bob Amosson made a motion to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Kristi Parks, The meeting was adjourned at 03:45 PM.

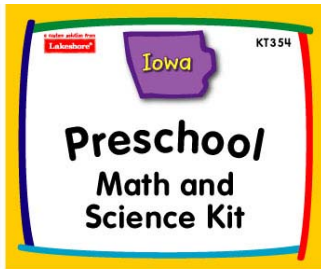
